

Academy Online learning hub We need your help!



The National Breast Imaging Academy project is an innovative package of solutions aimed at addressing the national workforce crisis in breast imaging.

Alongside the development of a national breast imaging fellowship programme, apprenticeships for mammography training and new training programmes for breast clinicians, a key element of the project is the creation of a national technology-enhanced learning hub for breast imaging.

The Academy Online learning hub will include e-learning resources covering the theoretical aspects of the core curriculum for all staff group as well as a large validated national case archive and simulation resources. Over time the learning hub will develop into a national online multidisciplinary forum to provide training, information, support and professional development for all breast imaging staff.

The project has been funded by HEE and is now moving into the development phase. This is an ambitious proposal, and its success will rely completely on the enthusiasm, experience and expertise of the breast imaging community.
