BSBR Audit Lead

The Audit Lead plays an important role in helping BSBR improve breast imaging practice and patient care across the UK. This is an opportunity to identify areas where services could benefit from greater consistency, updated guidance, or shared learning, and to work with colleagues to deliver projects that have a real impact.

Working with the Executive Committee and the wider membership, the Audit Lead helps develop and oversee national audit projects. This includes listening to members' ideas, identifying topics that matter to clinical practice, and assessing which projects are practical and achievable as well as leading large multidisciplinary teams to achieve the intended outputs. The role provides a unique opportunity to gain an overview of breast imaging services across the country and help drive improvements based on evidence and collaboration.

The Audit Lead will work with colleagues across BSBR, supporting the planning, governance and delivery of audits, from small, focused projects through to larger multicentre initiatives. Experience of audit, quality improvement or collaborative projects is important.

As a member of the BSBR Executive Committee, you'll contribute to wider Society activities and help shape future priorities for breast imaging practice.

The appointment is normally for three years, with the option to continue for a further term if mutually agreed. Applicants must be members of the BSBR in good standing with the Royal College of Radiologists.
