There is plenty of scope to bring your own ideas, whether that involves improving website design, functionality and content, developing activity across social media, or exploring new ways of engaging with our community.

The appointment is normally for three years, with the option to continue for a further term if mutually agreed. Applicants must be members of the BSBR in good standing with the Royal College of Radiologists.
