## **BSBR Education & Training Lead**

The Education & Training Lead plays an important role in supporting activities relating to education for both trainees and Consultant Radiologists.

Key responsibilities specific to the Education & Training Lead role include ensuring the RCR-BSBR Travelling Professor post and education bursaries are advertised, answering any queries from potential applicants and collating responses/ expressions of interest for committee discussion.

The Education & Training Lead acts as the liaison between the RCR-BSBR Travelling Professor, the BSBR Executive Committee and the Royal College of Radiologists ensuring the role administration is seamless. This includes providing support required for the educational visits arranged through each professor's year in post and guiding the end-of-year talk to be delivered at the corresponding Society Annual Scientific Meeting.

The Education & Training Lead will coordinate and potentially co-chair webinars presented by the BSBR and will liaise with the BSBR Executive Committee, speakers and the technical and digital communications teams to ensure the BSBR webinar programme is successful.

The Society Annual Scientific Meeting Education Session is organised and chaired by the Education & Training Lead. That organisation includes the creation and delivery the poster quiz and celebrating the winners of the proffered paper and poster sessions.

As a member of the BSBR Executive Committee, you'll contribute to the wider Society activities and help shape future priorities for breast imaging practice.

The appointment is normally for three years, with the option to continue for a further term if mutually agreed. Applicants must be members of the BSBR in good standing with the Royal College of Radiologists.
